CIF/Nepal invites professionals from the field of Social work and human services to apply for “Professional Exchange program” (PEP) with special focus on social and cross cultural exchange

Program: Program begins from November 18 – December 8, 2018. The program is divided into a one week “general program” for all participants and two weeks individual program in which the participants will be placed in different social organizations in Kathmandu and outside Kathmandu according to their interested fields. For the interested participants trekking/hiking to the mountain for one week will be arranged by CIF Nepal after completing the three weeks PEP (the cost of trekking is not included in the registration fee).

Language: The English language will be used during the program.

Number of participants: CIF Nepal will select 3-5 participants.

Registration fee: The fee is 500 Euros. The fee will be used to cover the cost of organizing the PEP program.

Support: Accommodation will be provided during the whole period. The first week in Kathmandu (General program) participants stay in a hostel, student housing or dormitory. During the individual program they stay with host families. Local travel with buses, breakfast and dinner will be provided during PEP.

Deadline for application: **15th September 2018**. Applications have to go through the CIF National Branch or Contact Person in your country. Programs during PEP:

- General program for all participants in the 1st week (takes place in Kathmandu).
- Presentation about the participant’s profession, work place and their own country.
- Introduction of Nepal’s social and cultural system.
- Sharing knowledge and discussion on social welfare systems with university students in school of social work.
- Information regarding social welfare activities conducted by Ministry of Women, Children and Social Welfare and Social Welfare Council Nepal.
- Visits of different social organizations/agencies.
- Regular meetings, observations and discussions with different agencies/authorities.
- Evaluation.
- Trekking to the Himalaya after the PEP.
